

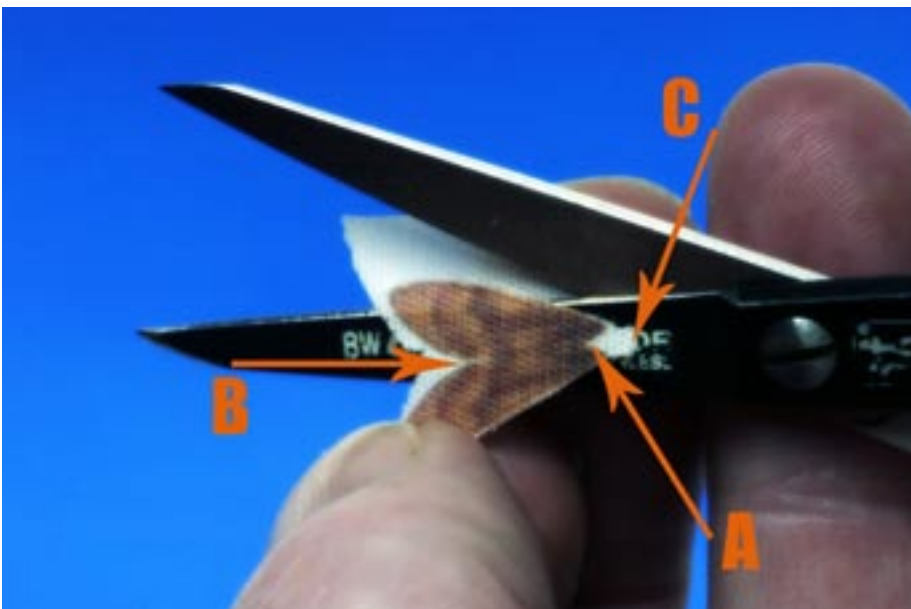
TYING WITH VIRTUAL NYMPH REALISTIC CADDIS WINGS



Step 1 - Select the colour you require and peel the silk wings from the paper backing.



Step 2 - Select a wing which looks the same length as the hook shank you are using. Fold the wing you have selected in half and measure it against the hook shank as illustrated. Point B should sit at the rear of the shank. Point C should sit behind the hook eye as illustrated in step 3.



Step 3 - Cut out the wings. Leave a white tie in tab as illustrated between points A and C. This tab can be used as a thorax cover if it is cut a little longer. Then coloured after tying off.

Tying Tip - Tie a small CDC body then tie on the wings. Finish of the thorax area with a deer hair head leaving long fibres for legs. Simple and quick !

Fishing Tip - Although the Caddis wings are waterproof, loading a lot of floatant onto the wing keeps it afloat all day.
